#### 1. ENTRIES:

- Entries OPEN May 1st, 2024 @ 8am
- Deadline June 14th, 2024 @ 9pm late fees applied for entries received after this date
- Website entries: www.CHARMD.ca
- Payment can be done through website when signing up

#### **2. FEES:**

- 12yrs & Under Exhibitor \$15/class or \$75/weekend
- 13yr & Over Exhibitor \$25/class or \$135/weekend
- Late Entries (all ages) after June 14th, 2024 @ 9pm -\$50/class or \$220/weekend
- Additional \$25/single or \$50/family non-CHARMD member fee
- "Weekend" is for single horse/rider combo, unlimited classes
- Full refunds until June 12th, 2024; after vet or doctor note required

#### 3. VENUE:

- Kaspian Equestrian Rock-N-Rail Ranch (Olds, AB) https://www.kaspianequestrian.com/map
- From Olds Head north at the set of lights (intersection of hwy 27 and 57th ave) head out of town past the hospital, the road turns into RR15. Turn left on the Netook Road twp rd 334 (west) and drive on pavement until range road 21 and the farm is on the left (south) side.

#### 4. STABLING:

- Indoor Stalls (18 available) \$35/night includes shavings, must be stripped prior to leaving
- Indoor stall for DAY USE \$15
- Outdoor Pens (10 available) \$15/night

#### 5. ACCOMODATIONS:

- 1x Plumbed Bathroom
- · Camping is free for no hookups
- \$15/night for plug-in
- Hotels less than 10mins away in Olds

### 6. CATERING:

- BUBBAQ BBQ Smokehouse will be putting on catered dinner June 22, 2024
- MUST sign-up and pay for before June 14th 2024
- \$30/person
- No refunds after June 14th, 2024 on meal tickets

#### 7. PHOTOGRAPHER:

- We have hired B. Martin Photography to be on site all weekend, photos will be <u>free for CHARMD members</u>
- \$40/Unlimited access to photos for non-club members

## 8. EQUINE:

- Any equine is eligible to compete
- Registered Canadian Horses must have CLRC registration (#) on entry form to enter as registered stock; exceptions made for this years foals.
- Age of horse shall be that reached during the calendar year 2024
- Stallions can only be handled by adults (18yr+), mature stallions must be shown with a chain in halter classes

#### 9. EXHIBITORS:

- ALL owners, exhibitors, riders, drivers and handlers
  MUST be current Alberta Equestrian Federation
  members (or other provincial sport organization with
  equivalent insurance)
- Junior exhibitors are under 18 yrs

**10. HELMETS:** Will never be penalized ... in any class! All youth exhibitors must have property fitted helmets when riding on site or in classes.

#### 11. GENERAL CHARMD RULES:

- This show will run under the rules of Equine Canada with the following local show rules:
  - a) The show committee reserves the right to decide any point not covered by the rules, prize list and/or programs/schedule, and to amend any rules it deems necessary.
  - b) The show committee reserve the right to remove any owner/lessee, trainer, groom, rider or horse from the show and/or the show grounds without being held liable for any compensation whatsoever.
  - c) CHARMD and Kaspian Equestrian will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to persons, horses, or property at this show. No entries will be accepted without signed releases.
  - d) Classes may be merged together based on attendance; but will be judged and scored in the class originally entered

## 12. PRIZES:

- Ribbons up to 6th place will be awarded
- Halter Champion, English Champion, Western Champion, Driven Champion, Junior Highpoint, Overall Highpoint, and Iron Horse Champion
- ONLY registered Canadian horses qualify for Iron Horse Champion

# **Kaspian Equestrian Training Centre Rules**

# Rock-N-Rail Ranch Inc.

- All users must sign Rock-N-Rail waiver(s) prior to participating in any activity.
- Smoking is permitted only within your personal vehicle or at the designated smoking area at the Kaspian Equestrian sign in the middle of the parking lot.
- Consumption of or being under the influence of non prescription hallucinogenic or mood-altering drugs of any description legal or illegal is not permitted on RNRR property.
- Alcoholic beverages may not be consumed in public areas.
  Consumption is allowed only in user provided mobile living quarters (campers).
- Food and beverages are not allowed in the Facilities performance areas (arena riding area).
- 6) All users must comply with the Equine Canada mandate for animal husbandry and fair and humane treatment of animals while training, riding and handling.
- 7) All users must comply with Equine Canada mandate for sportsmanlike conduct including: appropriate use of language, no gossip, support of one another, and discretion during lessons and training sessions.
- Helmets are to be worn at all times while mounted unless equipment waiver is signed.
- 9) The following equipment is banned from use at Kaspian Equestrian Training Centre: twisted wire bits, mechanical hackamores, gag bits, metal or cable core bosals, draw reins, sharpened spurs.

- 10) Industry standard dress code is in effect when handling, riding or assisting with horses: open-toed shoes, sandals are not acceptable, gloves are to be worn when lunging. Jackets must be worn with the jacket zipped or buttoned. No open jackets.
- 11) No horses are to be tied in the riding hall. We do not allow horses to be tied to trailers in the driveway without supervision due to liability risk and cleanup required.
- 12) All activity must stop if a rider or horse is in distress.
- Use of cross ties is for grooming and tacking ONLY. Never leave horses unattended in cross ties.
- 14) All Riders/coaches must clean up manure/urine immediately when possible or prior to leaving the arena.
- 15) Riders are responsible for barn cleanliness: clean and sweep grooming and holding stalls and barn aisle. Return brooms shovels etc. to storage locations.
- 16) Dogs are not permitted without prior consent. Absolutely no dogs allowed in arena or lower viewing areas.
- 17) Taking photos and videos of any member of the Kaspian staff, clients, horses or property is not permitted without the consent of the client and management of RNRR.
- 18) Social Media: clients and visitors are not permitted to post the names, images or comments about any member of the Kaspian staff, clients, horses or property without consent.
- Shut off lights and close doors whenever you are last out of a room.
